This pocket guide provides a quick reference for transportation modes available at Disney's Pop Century Resort. These routes are based on our experience.

From Disney's Pop Century:	Use:
Magic Kingdom	Resort Bus Service
Epcot	Skyliner
Disney's Hollywood Studios	Skyliner (Must Exit and Transfer at Disney's Caribbean Beach Resort.)
Disney's Animal Kingdom	Resort Bus Service
Disney Springs	Resort Bus Service
Disney's Blizzard Beach	Resort Bus Service (Must transfer at Disney's Animal Kingdom)
Disney's Typhoon Lagoon	Resort Bus Service (Must transfer at Disney Springs)
Monorail Resorts (Grand Floridian, Polynesian, Contemporary)	Take a bus to Magic Kingdom. Board the resort monorail outside the park's entrance.
Epcot Resorts (Beach Club, Yacht Club, Disney's Boardwalk, Swan and Dolphin)	Take the Skyliner to Epcot and walk or boat to any of these resorts.
Wilderness Lodge or Fort Wilderness	Take the Skyliner to Disney's Hollywood Studios. Take a bus to either resort.
Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge	Take a bus to Animal Kingdom. Board another bus to Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge.
