This pocket guide provides a quick reference for transportation modes available at Disney's Old Key West. These routes are based on our experience.

From Disney's Old Key West:	Use:
Magic Kingdom	Resort Bus Service
Epcot	Resort Bus Service
Disney's Hollywood Studios	Resort Bus Service
Disney's Animal Kingdom	Resort Bus Service
Disney Springs	Resort Bus Service or Water Taxi (Can also walk, but long distance.)
Disney's Blizzard Beach Disney's Typhoon Lagoon	-Resort Bus Service (Must transfer at Disney's Animal Kingdom) -Resort Bus Service (Must transfer at Disney Springs)
The Skyliner (Art of Animation, Pop Century, Caribbean Beach, Riviera)	Take a bus to Hollywood Studios to board the Skyliner.
Monorail Resorts (Grand Floridian, Polynesian, Contemporary)	Take a bus to Magic Kingdom. Board the resort monorail outside the park's entrance.
Epcot Resorts (Beach Club, Yacht Club, Boardwalk, Swan and Dolphin)	Take a bus to Hollywood Studios, walk or boat to any of these resorts.
Wilderness Lodge or Fort Wilderness	Take a bus to Magic Kingdom. Then boat or bus to Wilderness Lodge.
Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge	Take a bus to Animal Kingdom. Board another bus to Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge.
